

### **Register of business interests:**

Governing bodies and school staff have a responsibility to avoid any conflict between their business and personal interests and the affairs and interests of the school. A register of business interests must be established for governors.

The register must include all business interests such as directorships, share holdings and other appointments of influence within business or other organisations, which may have dealings with the school. The disclosures must also include business interests of immediate family and other relatives and individuals who may exert influence.

The register must include any other educational establishments that they govern and any relationships between school staff and members of the governing body.

The register for the Governing Body of St. John's Catholic Primary School for the academic year 2015/2016 is shown below:
